Year 6 to 7 Transition to St Peter's Catholic School

I hope this letter finds you well and that your child is looking forward to joining St Peter's this coming September. We are very much looking forward to welcoming them into our community.

It was with sadness that we learnt that due to increased rates of infection in the local area, induction days, interschool visits and events have had to be cancelled. It is very disappointing that our new Year 7 pupils will be unable to come and spend their traditional induction day with us at the end of June and indeed, you as parents will be unable to join us for the annual New Parents Evening.

However, by modern technology myself and/or Miss Hall have been able to meet most pupils virtually. We have been very impressed with the pupils that we have met via Microsoft Teams. We have also had lots of remote meetings with your child's primary school teacher and other appropriate staff and are now beginning to build a picture of each of our new pupils.


A 'Year 6 Passport' booklet has been sent to your child's primary school in which they will have the opportunity to inform us of what they think we need to know about them. Some academic transition activities have also been passed on to primary colleagues to support them in maintaining progress in readiness for St Peter's.

While pupils are unable to visit St Peter's now, we are currently putting together some videos and online material. There will be one for pupils and one for parents and we will direct you to these as soon as they are available.



Finally, while visits are not permitted this term, our understanding is that Summer Schools are still permitted to take place. I am therefore proposing to use this opportunity to allow your child to come and spend some time with us prior to starting in September. **Between Thursday 22nd July and Friday 30th July, I would like to give each new Year 7 pupil the opportunity to spend two or three days with us. They will attend some sample 'normal' lessons and take part in some enrichment activities to help them get used to the school and meet new people.** Each child will receive an invitation and the days and times cannot be changed. For us to plan this provision, I would be grateful if you could complete this [expression of interest form](#) to indicate that you would like your child to be receive a place, by Wednesday 23rd June. Once numbers are confirmed, full details will be communicated to you.
